BYLC signs agreement with Ministry of Youth and Sports



Bangladesh Youth Leadership Center (BYLC) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Department of Youth Development, Ministry of Youth and Sports, in an effort to jointly design and deliver leadership programs for Bangladeshi youth. Ejaj Ahmad, Founder and President of BYLC, and Asit Kumar Mukutmoni, Director General, Department of Youth Development, Ministry of Youth and Sports, signed the agreement in a ceremony held at the Jubo Bhaban on November 6, 2013.

During the program, Ejaj Ahmad said, "Collaboration across different sectors is critical in a developing economy like Bangladesh where resources are limited. Through this private-public partnership, we hope to build the teaching capacity of the ministry's trainers and introduce concepts of leadership to the ministry's existing youth development curriculum."
